

"Fruit Bearing" John 15:1-8

- I. Intro & Context: Fruit bearing
 - a. Importance (Jn. 15:2,8) (cf. Lk. 3:8,9; 6:43)
 - b. Defined
 - i. A scarcity of definitions (Lk. 3:8; Phil. 1:11; Heb. 13:15; Gal. 5:22)
 - ii. A suggested working definition: "The fruit Jesus is after are the results of a life lived for Him"
- II. Key: Remain in Christ (Jn. 15:1-9)
 - Through His Word (v. 7) (cf. Deut. 11:18-20; Josh. 1:7-8; Ps. 119;
 Col. 3:16) "Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you..." (Col. 3:16)
 - b. Through His love (v. 9) (cf. Rom. 8:38-89; Eph. 3:17-19; 1 Jn. 2:5; 4:12; 5:3; Jude 1:21) "... if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us" (1 Jn. 4:12)
 - c. Through the sacraments (cf. Mt. 28:19; Jn. 6:56; Rom. 6:3; 1 Cor. 12:13; Gal. 3:27)
 - Baptism (cf. Mt. 28:19; Rom. 6:3; 1 Cor. 12:13; Gal. 3:27) "For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ" (Gal. 3:27)
 - ii. Communion (cf. Mk. 14:22-25; Jn. 6:56; 1 Cor. 11:23-29) "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me, and I in them" (Jn. 6:56)
 - d. Through His Spirit (Jn. 14:15-17; Acts 1:4-5, 8; 2:1-4; Rom. 8:9; Gal. 5:16-25) "If anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ" (Rom. 8:9)
 - e. Through His Church
 - The Church is Jesus' body (Eph. 5:23; Col. 1:18, 24), made up of those who are "sanctified in Christ Jesus and called to be his holy people" (1 Cor. 1:2)
 - ii. To remain in Christ implies that we should remain in His body, the church (cf. Heb. 10:19-25)
- III. Note: Results are not your responsibility (Jn. 15:5) (e.g. Jonah 4; Acts 10:45; 1 Cor. 3:5-7) "So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow" (1 Cor. 3:6-7)


