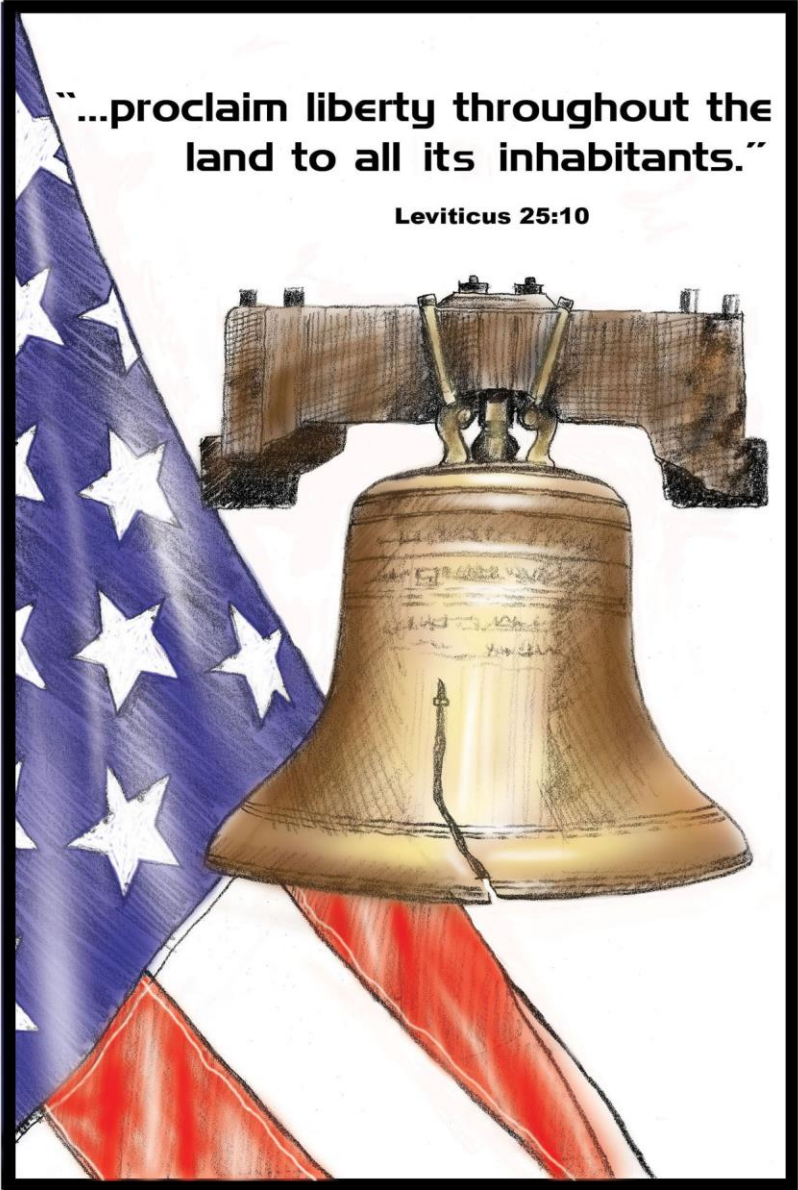

I. Intro & Context

II. Life application

- A. God tests (refines/prunes/cleanses/disciplines) us (v. 1) (cf. Deut. 8:5; Ps. 51:2; 66:10-12; 94:12; Pr. 15:10; Isa. 48:10-11; Jer. 9:7; Zech. 13:9; Mal. 3:1-4; 1 Cor. 11:31-32; Heb. 12:4-11)
- i. Because He loves us (Heb. 12:6) (cf. Pr. 3:11-12; Jn. 15:1-2,9; Rev. 3:19)
 - ii. B/c He wants us to be holy, righteous & filled w/ His peace (Lev. 11:45; 19:2; 20:7,26; Rom. 6:19-23; Eph. 1:4; 1 Thes. 4:7; Heb. 10:22; 12:10-11; 1 Pt. 1:15)
 - iii. B/c He wants to restore/reconcile us to Him (cf. Ps. 51:7-12; 80:4-7; Isa. 61; Jer. 33:8; Ezek. 37:23; Col. 1:21-23)
 - iv. B/c it makes us stronger (Ja. 1:2-3; 1 Pt. 5:10)
 - v. That we might receive the crown of life (Ja. 1:12) (cf. Ps. 103:4; Isa. 35; 51:11; 2 Pt. 1:3-11)
- B. God's jealousy (v. 12)
- i. He's jealous for His own name & reputation (Isa. 42:8; 48:10-11) (cf. Ezek. 36:16-23; Rom. 2:24)
 - ii. He won't tolerate being 2nd in our lives (i.e. Abraham & Isaac) (cf. Ex. 20:2-5; 34:14; Deut. 4:23-24; 32:16,21; Ps. 78:58; Ezek. 8; 23:25; Nah. 1:2; Zech. 1:4; 8:2; 1 Cor. 10:21-22; Ja. 4:4-5)
 - iii. A positive spin on jealousy: He knows what adultery brings and what it does to us. (cf. Jer. 3:6-9; Ezek. 23:37; Hosea 2; 4:13)
- C. God's provision (v. 14)
- i. We're given EVERYTHING we need for a godly life (2 Pt. 1:3-4) (cf. Ps. 23; 34:9-10; Jn. 16:23-24; 1 Cor. 1:7; 1 Jn. 3:21-22)
 - ii. The resulting harvest: righteousness & peace (Heb. 12:11) (cf. Job 42:10-17; Ps. 66:12; Isa. 32:17; Jn 4:36; Gal. 6:7-9; Ja. 3:18)
