"Dangerous Deception" Genesis 29:15-28

- 1) Intro & Context: A deceitful family
 - a) Jacob "the deceiver"
 - i) Jacob's birth and naming (Gen. 25:21-27)
 - ii) Swindled birthright (Gen. 25:29-34)
 - iii) Parents' bad example (Gen. 26:1-11)
 - iv) Stolen blessing (Gen. 27:1-40)
 - v) Deceptive business practices (Gen. 30:25-42)
 - vi) Running away from Laban (Gen. 31:17-21)
 - b) Laban's deceitfulness
 - i) Leah given instead of Rachel (Gen. 29:23,25)
 - ii) Deceptive wages (Gen. 31:6-7)
 - c) Rachel's deception (a stolen idol) (Gen. 31:19, 30-35)
 - d) Jacob's sons' deception
 - i) A slaughtered tribe (Gen. 34)
 - ii) A "lost" brother (Gen. 37:12-36)
 - e) Judah deceived by Tamar, his daughter-in-law (Gen. 38)
 - f) Result: Strained relationships
 - i) Esau's hatred toward Jacob (Gen. 27:41)
 - ii) Rachel & Leah's sisterly jealousy (Gen. 29:30; 30:1,8,14-15)
 - iii) Divided families (Gen. 27:42-45; 31:1-21,26-28)
 - iv) Hostility among nations (Gen. 34:30)
 - v) Joseph sold by his brothers into slavery (Gen. 37:12ff)
 - g) Despite it all, God still was gracious to this family!!
- 2) Lessons learned from a biblical study on "deceit"
 - Deceit is sin (Ps. 32:2; 52:1-4; Pr. 12:20; Isa. 5:18; Rom. 1:29; 1 Pt. 2:1) "Nothing impure will ever enter [heaven], nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful..." (Rev. 21:27)
 - b) Deceit is destructive (Pr. 6:14; 26:18,19; Zech. 10:2; Mk. 4:19; 7:21-23) "Like a maniac shooting flaming arrows of death is one who deceives their neighbor and says, "I was only joking!" (Pr. 26:18-19)
 - c) It is pervasive (Jer. 6:13; 8:10; 9:5; 2 Tim. 3:12-13; 2 Jn. 1:7) "From the least to the greatest, all are greedy for gain; prophets and priests alike, all practice deceit." (Jer. 6:13)
 - Note: Esp. in end times (cf. Dan. 8:17-25; Mt. 24:24; 2 Thes. 2:9-12; Rev. 13:13-14; 19:20) "For false messiahs and false prophets will appear and perform great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect." (Mt. 24:24)

- d) God will judge harshly those who practice deceit (Ps. 5:6; 101:7; Isa.
 5:18,20; Jer. 5:26-29; 9:8-9; Rev. 21:27) "You destroy those who tell lies.
 The bloodthirsty and deceitful you, LORD, detest." (Ps. 5:6)
- 3) Action steps
 - a) Cleanse your heart of deceit.
 Note: Beware of our tendency toward self-deception—"The heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it?" (Jer. 17:9)
 - b) Recognize it and repent of it (Ps. 51:2,7,10; 1 Pt. 2:1; Eph. 4:25; Col. 3:9-10) "Therefore each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to your neighbor..." (Eph. 4:25)
 - c) Live into truth (Ps. 26:3; 43:3; 119:11,30,105; Jn. 3:21; Ja. 1:16-18; 1 Jn. 1:6-10; 3 Jn. 4) "But whoever lives by the truth comes into the light..." (Jn. 3:21)
 - i) In your home
 - ii) In your workplace
 - iii) In your church
