

"Good Fear" Philippians 2:1-13

- 1) Intro & Context
- 2) "Work out your salvation" (cf. Mt. 24:10-13; 1 Cor. 9:24-27; Heb 3:14; 6:9-11; 2 Pt. 1:5-8)
 - a. Don't let your love grow cold b/c of the onslaught of wickedness; stand firm to the end! (Mt. 24:10-13)
 - b. E.g. Like racing: Run to win! Be severe toward yourself. Don't allow yourself to be disqualified (1 Cor. 9:24-27)
 - c. Don't allow sin & unbelief to cause your heart to turn from God; hold firmly to your convictions to the end (Heb. 3:12-14)
 - d. Don't become lazy, be diligent to the very end (Heb. 6:9-11)
 - e. Make every effort to add to your faith, working on your X'n character; this will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive; doing so, you'll never stumble (2 Pt. 1:5-8)
- 3) "With fear and trembling"
 - a. Those who fear: Obey God, love Him, and serve Him whole-heartedly (Deut. 10:12-13); shun evil (Job 1:8); are humble (Pr. 22:4); prattle not in His presence (Eccl. 5:1-7)
 - those who do not fear: Are wicked (Ps. 36:1); engage in witchcraft, liars, adulterers, those who defraud, oppress widows & orphans, unjust toward immigrants (Mal. 3:5); seek not the good, deceitful, full of cursing & bitterness, violent (Rom. 3:11-15)
 - c. Benefits of fearing God: Keeps us from sinning (Ex. 20:20; Pr. 16:6); establishes in us integrity (Neh. 7:2); God attends to their prayers (Ps. 33:18); the angel of the Lord encamps around them (Ps. 34:7); leads to wisdom (Ps. 111:10; Isa. 33:6); is a fountain of life (Pr. 14:27); leads to salvation (Isa. 33:6); causes the church to grow (Acts 9:31;
 - d. Consequences of not fearing God: A short life (Eccl. 8:13); ruin & misery; no peace (Rom. 3:16-17); a dreadful judgment before God (Heb. 10:31).
- 4) "For it is God who works in you" (cf. Ez. 1:1,5; Hag. 1:14; 1 Cor. 12:6; 15:10; Gal. 2:8; Col. 1:29; Heb. 13:20-21) "I strenuously contend with all the energy Christ so powerfully works in me" (Col. 1:29)
- 5) "To will and to act according to his good purpose" (cf. Gal. 5:6; Eph. 1:5; Ja. 2:18,20,22)
