Exodus 33:12-23

- 1) Intro & Context
- 2) Known by name (vv. 12,17) (cf. Isa. 43:1; 49:1; Jer. 1:5; Ps. 139:15-16; Jn. 10:14; Rom. 8:29) “But the man who loves God is known by God” (1 Cor. 8:3)
- 3) Finding favor with God (vv. 12,13) (cf. Gen. 6:8; Ps. 5:12; 84:11; Pr. 3:34; 12:2; Dan. 9:13; Luke 1:28,30; 2:14,52; Ja. 4:6; 1 Pt. 5:5) “Whoever seeks good finds favor, but evil comes to one who searches for it” (Pr. 11:27)
- 4) Taught by God (v. 13) (cf. Ps. 25:4-5; 86:11; 119:12; 143:8-10; Mt. 28:20; Jn. 6:45; 14:23-24; Heb. 8:10-11; 1 Thes. 4:9) “Teach me, LORD, the way of your decrees, that I may follow it to the end” (Ps. 119:33)
- 5) Insisting on God’s Presence (vv. 14-16) (cf. Ex. 13:21; Deut. 4:37; Isa. 41:10; 63:9; Hag. 2:4; 2 Ki. 24:20; Ps. 51:11; Jer. 52:3; Mt. 28:20; Rom. 8:31) “... If God is for us, who can be against us?” (Rom. 8:31)
- 6) Experiencing God’s glory (v. 18) (cf. Ex. 16:6-8, 10; Deut. 5:23-27; 1 Ki. 19:11-13; Ps. 63:1-4; Isa. 6:1-5; 40:3-5; Ez. 1:28; Jn. 1:14; 12:41; 1 Ti. 6:15-16; Rev. 15:8) “This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD. When I saw it, I fell facedown...” (Ez. 1:28)
 - a. His goodness (v. 19) (cf. Ps. 23:6; 34:8; 86:17; 100:5; Mk. 10:18; Eph. 5:8-9; 2 Pt. 1:3; 3 Jn. 11) “... No one is good—except God alone” (Mk. 10:18)
 - b. His name (v. 19) (cf. Ex. 3:14; 34:5-7; Dan. 2:20; Ps. 20:1,7; 75:1; Jn. 3:18; Acts 4:10; Heb. 13:15; Rev. 3:12)
 - c. His face (vv. 20,23) (cf. Ex. 3:6; Jn. 1:18; Col. 1:14; 1 Tim. 6:16; 1 Jn. 4:12) “God... who alone is immortal and who lives in unapproachable light, whom no one has seen or can see...” (1 Tim. 6:16)
- 7) Our relationship with God (cf. Jer. 9:23-24; Jn. 17:3; Eph. 4:13; Php. 3:10) “Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent” (Jn. 17:3)
