

"In Need of a Savior" Mark 13:24-37

- 1) Intro & Context
- 2) Why we need a Savior (Isa. 64:1-9)
 - a. Prayer for God's coming down (vv. 1-3) (cf. Ps. 18:7-15; 144:5-8; Jn. 1:32-33; 6:32-58; 1 Thess. 4:16)
 - Hope in the midst of despair (v. 4) (cf. Ps. 27:14; Isa. 30:18; 40:31; Lam. 3:25-26; Rom. 8:22-25; 1 Cor. 2:9; Tit. 2:11-14) "It is good to wait quietly for the salvation of the Lord" (Lam. 3:26)
 - Our filthy nature (vv. 5-6) (cf. Lev. 13:45-46; 15:19-24; Ezek. 36:17; Rom. 3:9-18,23; Gal. 3:22) "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Rom. 3:23)
 - d. Wasting away (v. 7) (cf. Lev. 26:14-39; Isa. 9:18; Ps. 32:1-5; 106:43; 112:10; Ezek. 24:20-24; Hos. 4:1-3) "Many times he delivered them, but they were bent on rebellion and they wasted away in their sin" (Ps. 106:43)
 - e. The Potter & His clay (v. 8) (cf. Job 10:9; 33:6; Isa. 29:16; 45:9; Jer. 18:6; 2 Cor. 4:7)
- 3) Revival prayer (Ps. 80:1-7, 17-19)
 - a. Crying for a Savior (v. 2) (cf. Ps. 60:5; 106:47; 108:6; Tit. 3:5)
 - b. Drinking tears by the bowlful (Job 16:20; Ps. 6:6; 42:3; 56:8; 102:9; 126:5; Isa. 30:20; Jer. 9:1,18; Lam. 1:16; 2:18; 3:48; Acts 20:19,31; Heb. 5:7) "Those who sow with tears will reap with songs of joy " (Ps. 126:5)
 - c. Praying for restoration (vv. 3,7,19) "Restore us, O Lord God Almighty; make your face shine upon us, that we may be saved" (cf. Ps. 14:7; 53:6; 85:4; Isa. 57:18; 58:9-12; Jer. 31:18; Hos. 6:1-2; 1 Pt. 5:10)
- 4) Watching w/ vigilance (Mk. 13:24-37)
 - a. Jesus' return (vv. 24-27) (cf. Isa. 13:9-10; 34:4; Mt. 24:29-31; Rev. 19:11-21)
 - Warned to be vigilant (vv. 28-31) (cf. Mt. 25:13; Mk. 13:32-37;
 Lk. 21:34-36; Col. 4:2; 2 Jn. 1:8) "Devote yourselves to prayer,
 being watchful and thankful" (Col. 4:2)
 - c. Kept strong to the end by Christ, blameless (1 Cor. 1:8)
