

# "Thriving: Maximizing Your Talents" Luke 19:11-27

Key Thought: God wants us to use our resources to the best of our abilities to maximize the impact for His Kingdom growth.

Key Text: "For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each of us may receive what is due us for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad." (2 Cor. 5:10)

- 1. Intro & Context (Stewardship of our talents)
- 2. Defining our "Talents." What are the internal resources you possess? "For who makes you different from anyone else? What do you have that you did not receive? And if you did receive it, why do you boast as though you did not?" (1 Cor. 4:7)
  - (a) Natural talents (i.e. "born with it," or developed naturally)
    - i. Innate talents: Intelligence, aptitude, creativity, leadership, relational skills, teaching, etc.
    - ii. Physical talents: Strength, agility, stamina, etc.
    - iii. Intellectual talents: Educational, vocational, experiential
    - iv. Emotional: Empathy, compassion, stability, passion, etc.
  - (b) Gifting (i.e. Spirit-given) (cf. Rom. 12:6-8; 1 Cor. 12:4-11)
    - i. Spiritual: wisdom, prophecy, leadership, teaching, faith, service, encouragement, generosity, etc.
    - ii. Forgiveness, grace, mercy, zeal, etc.
    - iii. Your testimony
- 2. God's part: What resources has God invested in you? Note: May need a spiritual gifts inventory to answer this one.
  - "Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows." (Ja. 1:17)
- 3. Our part: What could you do to maximize those resources, that you might increase your leverage [your influence, your fruitfulness] and thereby effect more growth for God's Kingdom? (cf. Mt. 25:14-30; Eph. 4:11-13)
  - (a) Educational growth (formal or informal)
  - (b) Experiential growth (Work to gain more experience)
  - (c) Faith growth (Mission trips & Outreach ministries)
  - (d) More involvement in church (esp. in leadership)
- 4. Why it matters: We will be judged according to our works (cf. Rom. 14:10; 1 Cor. 3:12-15; 2 Cor. 5:10; Rev. 20:11-15)
- 5) It's all about love (Gal. 5:6b; 1 Cor. 13:1-3; 1 Jn. 4:16-18)
- 6) Conclusion


We have sign-up sheets in the gathering area for cleaning crews…but we need members to sign-up to help keep our church clean and beautiful!
