"Saved By Grace" Ephesians 2:1-10

Key Text: "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God" (Eph. 2:8)

Key Thought: In Christ, we move from death to life, being saved by grace, through faith, which inspires us on to good works, which complete our faith.
