

"Imitating God" Ephesians 5:1-7

Key Thought: We are called to imitate God in His love and righteousness.

- Key Verse: "But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do" (1 Pt. 1:15)

 - God's wrath will come of the disobedient (v. 6b) (cf. Jn. 3:36; Rom. 1:18-32; Gal. 5:19-21)
 - d. Don't partner with the disobedient (v. 7) (cf. Pr. 1:10-15; 5:1-8; 7:24-27; Mt. 5:29-30; 1 Cor. 5:11; 2 Thes. 3:6,14)


S.P.L.A.S.H. NOTICE
