

"Out With the Old!" Ephesians 4:17-24

Key Text: "Whoever claims to live in him must live as Jesus did" (1 John 2:6)

Key Thought: As followers of Christ, we need to walk in His ways, and not in the ways of the world.

Please feel free to join the group.


