

"Living Wisely" Ephesians 5:15-21

Key Text: "Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ..." (Php. 1:27)

Key Thought: We are called to live wisely in these dark times.

- 1) Intro & Context
- 2) Careful & wise living (v. 15) (cf. ALL of Proverbs; Mt. 7:24-27; 25:1-13; Lk. 12:35-48; Rom. 16:19) "Everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock" (Mt. 7:24)
- 3) Maximizing every opportunity (v. 16) (cf. Mt. 25:14-30; Lk. 16:1-10; Col. 4:5)
- 4) Understanding God's will (v. 17) (cf. Rom. 12:1-2; Col. 1:9-11)
- 5) Filled with the Spirit (v. 18) (cf. Rom. 8:5-14; Gal. 5:22-25)
- 6) Mouths filled with songs (v. 19a) (cf. 1 Cor. 14:26) (E.g. Col. 1:15-20; Php. 2:6-11) "Let the word of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit..." (Col. 3:16)
- 7) Hearts filled with music (v. 19b) (E.g. Ex. 15:1-10; Jdg. 5; Ps. 18; 30; 34).
- 8) Always thankful (v. 20) (cf. Ps. 34:1; Php. 4:6; Col. 3:15) "Give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus" (1 Ths. 5:18)
- 9) Mutual submission (v. 21) (cf. 1 Cor. 9:19; Eph. 5:22-6:9; 1 Pt. 3:8; 5:5) "... serve one another in love" (Gal. 5:13)
- 10) Conclusion

Questions for Reflection (or "Lunch Conversation Topics"):

- Would others describe you as one who lives wisely, or foolishly?
- Who controls your life? Do you, or God's Spirit?
- What's filling your heart? Stress, anxiety, sadness, anger... or thanksgiving and music for the Lord?
