

"Dressed for Battle" Ephesians 6:13-18

Key Text: "Put on the full armor of God..." (v. 11a)

Key Thought: In our confrontations with evil, we must depend on God and arm ourselves with His resources to fight the good fight, and to hold our ground.

- 1) Intro & Context
- 2) Standing in the day of evil (v. 13)
 - a. "The meaning is, 'any time evil is encountered." (Klyne Snodgrass) (e.g. 1 Kgs. 18:16ff; Mt. 4:1-10; Acts 5:17-42)
 - b. Stand not in your power, but in God's (cf. Ps. 44:3,6-7; 60:12; Pr. 21:31; Zech 4:6)
 - c. Victors will receive heavenly rewards (cf. Rev. 2:7,10; 3:5,12,21; 21:7-8) "I take no pleasure in the one who shrinks back" (Heb. 10:38b)
- 3) The belt of truth (v. 14a) (cf. Isa. 11:5; Ps. 119:165; Eph. 4:15,25; 5:9)
- 4) The breastplate of righteousness (v. 14b) (cf. Job 29:14-17; Isa. 59:17; Rom. 4; 2 Cor. 6:7)
- 5) Feet fitted with readiness—a result of the gospel of peace (v. 15) (cf. Isa. 52:7; 2 Tim. 4:2; 1 Pt. 3:15)
- 6) The shield of faith (v. 16) (Ps. 91:4; Heb. 10:38; 11:6; 1 Jn. 5:4) "... he shields all who take refuge in him" (Ps. 18:30)
- 7) The helmet of salvation (v. 17a) (cf. Isa. 59:17; 1 Ths. 5:8-9; 1 Pt. 1:3-5)
- The sword of the Spirit (v. 17b) (cf. Isa. 49:2; Heb. 4:12; Rev. 1:16; 2:12,16; 19:15)
- 9) Prayer: A powerful force (v. 18) (cf. Jn. 14:12; 15:7) *"The prayer of the righteous is powerful and effective"* (Ja. 5:16b)
- 10) Declaring the gospel fearlessly (vv. 19-20) (cf. Acts 4:29; Rom. 1:16; 2 Tim. 1:7-8)
- 11) Conclusion

Questions for Reflection:

- When have you been aware of having a confrontation with evil? How did you handle it? Did you feel you came out "standing?"
- What resources of God must you sharpen your skill in so that you can "fight the good fight of faith?"
- In regards to a life of faith, are you fearless? Are you strong and courageous? What could you do to become so?
