Prayer Chain

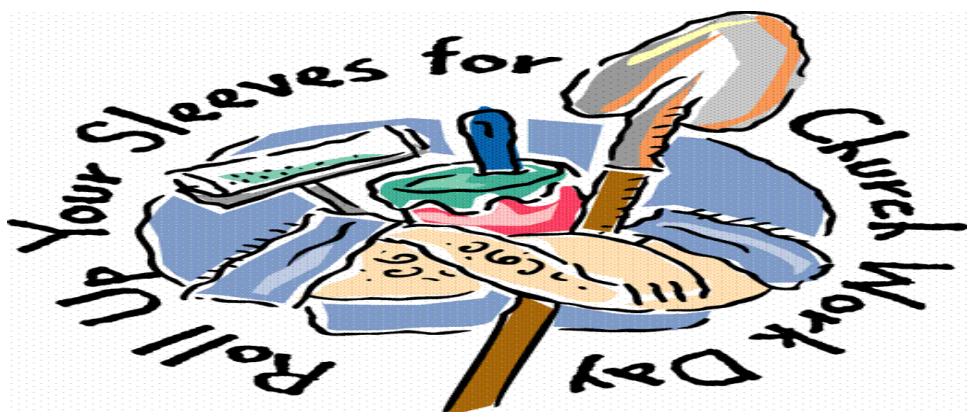
