# "Did You Get What You Wanted for Christmas?" Luke 2:25-35

**Key Text:** "He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him" (John 1:11)

**Key Thought:** The baby born in Jerusalem was NOT what many people wanted in a Messiah. So it is that we must also wrestle with whether or not to accept this "gift of God."

## Questions for Reflection

- Is God's gift worth the cost? What do you stand to lose by accepting it? What do you stand to lose by rejecting it?
- Paul said, "I preached that they should repent and turn to God and prove their repentance by their deeds" (Acts 26:20). What "deeds" does Paul expect of Christ-followers?
- As a Christian, have you denied yourself and taken up your cross? What would that look like in our context today? Are you willing to do that?
