

"Faith Overhaul #7: Suffer Willingly" 2 Corinthians 4:7-18

Key Text: "Therefore, since Christ suffered in his body, arm yourselves also with the same attitude..." (1 Pt. 4:1)

Key Thought: Our faith will never be strong and true until we are willing to suffer for Christ and for His Kingdom.

They meet @9:15 a.m. There will be coffee, tea & donuts. Join us as we grow closer to God and with each other.




"An In-Depth Study of Ephesians"
