

## "Faith Overhaul #9: Integrity" 1 John 3:1-10

**Key Text:** "No one who lives in him keeps on sinning. No one who continues to sin has either seen him or known him" (1 Jn. 3:6)

**Key Thought:** A true faith exercises true repentance; a saving faith results in holiness, for those who love God hate sin.

- 1) Intro & Context: E.g. Rules of the house
- 2) Truth #1: God hates sin (And so should we!) (cf. Ps. 97:10; Pr. 8:13; Rom. 12:9)
- 3) Truth #2: God punishes sin (cf. Hos. 8:13
  - a. His wrath will come upon those who are unrepentant (cf. Rom. 1:18; 2:8; Eph. 5:6) "Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of such things God's wrath comes on those who are disobedient" (Eph. 5:6)
  - b. God's love is NOT unconditional (Hos. 9:15; 2 Pt. 2:20-22)

    "Because of their sinful deeds, I will drive them out of my house.
    I will no longer love them" (Hos. 9:15)
- 4) Truth #3: God demands repentance (cf. 1 Cor. 15:34; Lk. 13:3; Acts 3:19; James 4:8)
- 5) Truth #4: God defines right and wrong (cf. Pr. 3:5-7; 26:12; Isa. 5:20-21; 1 Cor. 1:20)
- 6) Truth #5: God longs to redeem us
  - a. He is willing to forgive our sins (cf. Micah 7:18; Eph. 1:7; Col. 2:13)
  - b. He is willing to cleanse us of our sins (cf. Jer. 33:8; 1 Jn. 1:9)
  - c. He is willing to free us from our sins (cf. Rom. 6:1-14; Gal. 5:1; 1 Pt. 4:1)
- 7) Truth #6: Only those who are holy will enter heaven (cf. Mt. 5:20; Rom. 6:22; Heb. 12:14)
  - a. Set apart: Forgiven, cleansed & redeemed (cf. Acts 3:19; Rev. 22:14-15)
  - b. Robed in Christ's righteousness (cf. 1 Cor. 1:30; 2 Cor. 5:21)
  - c. Sanctified by the Holy Spirit (filled, sanctified and controlled by the Holy Spirit) (cf. Rom. 15:16; 1 Cor. 6:11; 1 Ths. 4:3)
- 8) Closing

#### Questions for Reflection:

- Are you under Christ's control, or under the control of sin?
- Are you walking in sincere repentance? Do you hate sin (as God defines it)?
- Are you allowing Christ to help you be free from your besetting sin(s)?


#### OUTSIDE WORK MORNING
