

"A Fine Reputation" Colossians 1:1-8

Key Text: "Encouraging, comforting and urging you to live lives worthy of God, who calls you into his kingdom and glory" (1 Thess. 2:12)

Key Thought: A good Christian reputation must be the outgrowth of our identity in Christ, and His Spirit working in us.

 - c. The gospel bearing fruit & growing among them (v. 6) (cf. Mt. 28:19-20; Jn. 15:16)

- What kind of reputation do you have? Are you content with it?
- What do you think God's opinion is of you? Do you think He's disappointed, or proud?
- What is the basis of your personal identity? Your work & job performance, your family name and reputation, your social status, your credentials... or being saved by grace thru Christ Jesus?
- If you were to live out of (and into) your God-given identity, how would that affect your reputation going forward?


