

The Apostle's Prayer, Pt. 2" Colossians 1:9-14

Key Text: "For he has rescued us from the dominion [tyranny] of darkness and brought [transferred] us into the kingdom of the Son he loves" (Col. 1:13)

Key Thought: Having been rescued from the tyranny of darkness, God has established us as His children of light, and has called us to the ministry of reconciliation.

- I. Intro & Context: Paul's prayer for them
- II. Qualified to share an incredible inheritance (v. 12b) (cf. Mt. 25:34; 1 Pt. 1:4; Rev. 21:1-7) "Those who are victorious will inherit all this, and I will be their God and they will be my children" (Rev. 21:7)
 - A. "This is a qualification for inheritance due solely to the grace of God" (Johnson).
 - B. Jesus' sacrifice made it possible "B/c by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy" (Heb. 10:14)
- III. Rescued from the dominion of darkness (v. 13)
 - A. Jesus' purpose (cf. Isa. 9:2; 42:7; 61:1; Jn. 1:4-5,9) "I have come into the world as a light, so that no one who believes in me should stay in darkness" (Jn. 12:46)
 - B. Paul's calling: "to open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God" (Acts 26:18)
 - C. Our calling, identity & purpose (cf. 1 Ths. 5:5; 1 Pt. 2:9) "For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light" (Eph. 5:8)
- IV. In Jesus, we have redemption & forgiveness (v. 14) (cf. Acts 26:18; Eph. 1:7)
 - A. Our redemption is through grace, and in Christ Jesus (cf. Rom. 3:24; Eph. 1:7,14)
 - B. Forgiveness (Mt. 26:28; Lk. 1:77; Acts 13:38)
 - C. Our call to this "ministry of reconciliation" (2 Cor. 5:18)
- V. Conclusion

Questions for Reflection

- Do you understand—truly understand—what God has done for you in rescuing you from the tyranny of darkness? Does your love, admiration, honor and worship of God reflect that?
- Do you have the strong assurance of your "qualification" for the inheritance of the saints?

- Are you walking in the light? Or do you still spend too much time in darkness?
- Do you understand God's call to share this good news with others who are under the enemy's tyrannical control? How are you actively responding to that call?


Monday Evening Prayer Gathering
