

# "The Parable of the Sower" Mark 4:1-20

**Key Text:** "This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples" (John 15:8)

**Key Thought:** In a true follower of Jesus Christ, the effect of God's Word in him/her should always produce an abundance of fruit.

- 2) The \_\_\_\_\_ of the parables
  - a. Kingdom secrets (v. 11) (cf. 1 Cor. 2; Eph. 3:2-6) "... even angels long to look into these things" (1 Pt. 1:12)
  - b. Given to the disciples (cf. 1 Pt. 1:10-12; Col. 1:26)
  - c. Withheld from "outsiders" (cf. Isa. 6:9-10; Rom. 11:7-10)
- 3) Defining \_\_\_\_\_\_ "The ax is already at the root of the trees, and every tree that does not produce good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire" (Mt. 3:10)
  - a. The fruit of our witness (Col. 1:6)
  - b. The fruit of repentance (Mt. 3:8)
  - c. The fruit of righteousness (Ps. 72:3; Pr. 11:30; Php. 1:11)
  - d. The fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22-23)
  - e. The importance of fruit-bearing (cf. Mt. 21:43; Lk. 3:6-9) "This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples." (Jn. 15:2,8)
- 4) The Parable of the Sower
  - a. Seed falling along the path (i.e. Mk. 3:22; Acts 13:45)
  - b. Seed falling on rocky places (cf. Rev. 2:4, 10, 25-26; 3:5, 8-12, 21)
  - c. Seed falling among thorns
    - "Worries of this life" (cf. Mt. 6:25-34; Php. 4:6) "...do not fret—it leads only to evil" (Ps. 37:8)
    - "The deceitfulness of wealth" (cf. Mt. 19:23-24; 1 Tim. 6:9-10)
    - "The desires for other things" (cf. 1 Jn. 2:15; Ja. 4:4)
  - d. Seed falling on good soil (cf. Mt. 7:17-19; 12:33; Col. 1:10)
- 5) The hard, personal questions
  - Are you generating abundant fruit for Christ's honor & glory?
  - If not, is your "soil" too shallow? How can you increase your "soil depth"?
  - Or are there too many "weeds" in your heart, choking out good growth and fruitfulness? What steps can you take for better "weed control" over your heart?

# **Prayer Gatherings**


