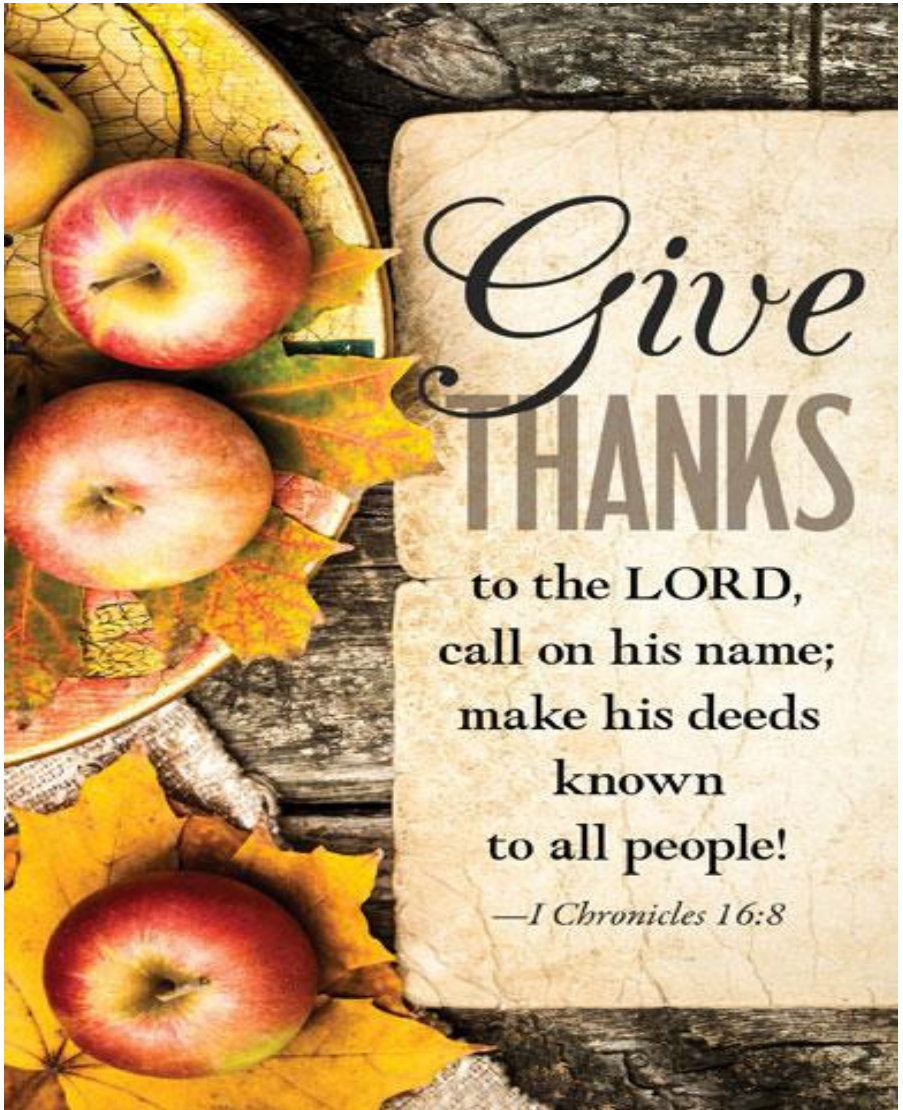

Mark 16:1-20

Key Text: “... *In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead*” (1 Pt. 1:4)
