"Winning Over a King" Nehemiah 2:1-8

Key Text: "But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me was not without effect..." (1 Cor. 15:10)

Key Thought: As was true of Nehemiah, we can receive God's flow of grace, and become full of grace and gracious persons.

 - a) Let grace **DEFINE** you!! (1 Cor. 15:10)
 - b) Boldly approach His throne of grace (Heb. 4:16)
