Sermon Notes February 24, 2019 "Doing Justly, Loving Mercy" Job 24:1-12 Nehemiah 5:1-12

Key Text: *"He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God"* (Micah 6:8)

Key Thought: As Nehemiah did, we must take as stand against injustice and defend the rights of the poor and downtrodden.

 - d) TAKE A STAND for the poor & downtrodden (Isa. 58:6-12; James 1:27)
 - e) Get INVOLVED! (e.g. Isa. 1:15-17; Micah 6:8)

- 2. Where do you feel drawn to serve in this regard? Will you commit to it? What first steps will you take to get involved?
