Sermon Notes May 19, 2019 "Strong Leadership" Nehemiah 13:4-11, 15, 23-28

Key Text: "Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord" (Rom. 12:11)

Key Thought: As with Nehemiah, what is needed in our world today is strong leadership to influence godly reforms

- 1) Intro & Context
- 2) Nehemiah's <u>REFORMS</u> (chpt. 12)
- 3) VIOLENCE in the Bible (cf. Num. 25:7-8; 1 Sam. 17:51; Jn. 2:13-17)
- 4) Practicing <u>STRONG</u> leadership
 - a) Caution: Stay within the law! (cf. Rom. 13:1-7; 1 Pt. 2:17; 3:15)
 - b) <u>**RISK</u> it all! (cf. Lk. 14:26-27; Jn. 12:25)**</u>
 - c) Speak up! (cf. Ps. 82:3; Jer. 22:16) "Speak up and judge fairly; defend the rights of the poor and needy" (Pr. 31:9)
 - d) Act! (cf. Ja. 2:14-17; 4:17) "Anyone, then, who knows the good he ought to do and doesn't do it, sins" (Ja. 4:17)
 - e) <u>LEAD!!</u> (cf. Mt. 5:13-16; Php. 2:15-16) *"In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven"* (Mt. 5:16)
