

Sermon Notes June 23, 2019 "Experiencing Acts: Courageous Witness" Acts 4:8-21

Key Text: "'… You must go to everyone I send you to and say whatever I command you. Do not be afraid of them, for I am with you and will rescue you,' declares the Lord" (Jer. 1:7-8)

Key Thought: As Peter and John witnessed courageously, so we also must pray that God would make us courageous in our witness for Him

- 6) <u>COURAGEOUS</u> witness (4:13) (cf. Jer. 1:7-8; Ezek. 2:6-7; Mt. 10:26-28)
