

Sermon Notes July 7, 2019 "Amazing Church Fellowship" Acts 2:42-47; 4:32-37

Key Text: "All the believers were one in heart and mind..." (Acts 4:32)

Key Thought: In these passages, we see a beautiful example of amazing Christian fellowship among the early believers which should inspire us in our own church context.

 - Breaking of <u>BREAD</u> (2:42, 46) (cf. Acts 2:42,46; 1 Cor. 11:33; Jude 12)
- Shared <u>RESOURCES</u> (2:45; 4:32, 34-37) "God's grace was so powerfully at work in them all" (cf. 2 Cor. 8-9; James 1:27)
- 4) Public and private fellowship
 - a. Public gatherings (2:46) (cf. Acts 3:1; 5:21,42)
 - b. Home fellowship (2:46) (cf. Acts 16:14-15; Phm. 1-2)
- Results: <u>FAVOR</u> (cf. Pr. 16:7; 2 Cor. 1:11) and <u>GROWTH</u> (2:47) (cf. Acts 4:4; 5:14; 16:5; 19:20)




