

Sermon Notes July 21, 2019 "Experiencing Acts: Civil Disobedience" Acts 5:17-21a; 27-32

Key Text: "... do not be afraid of those who kill the body and after that can do no more... Fear him who, after your body has been killed, has authority to throw you into hell. Yes, I tell you, fear him." (Luke 12:4-5)

Key Thought: As the apostles did, we must fear God more than any human threat, and boldly proclaim our faith in Christ
