

Sermon Notes October 27, 2019

"Experiencing Acts: Cultivating for Revival" Acts 19:8-20

Key Text: "Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord, and that he may send the Christ, who has been appointed for you—even Jesus" (Acts 3:19-20)

Key Thought: As seen in this text, cultivating a true revival involves true confession and repentance, and gives true, enduring results

- 6) A riot over **IDOLS** (vv. 23-41) (cf. Ex. 20:4; Isa. 40:18-20; 44:9-20)
- 7) Conclusion

- As Paul did, how can we "go public" more with the gospel?
- Toward personal revival, what sin(s) do you need to confess? With whom could you open up to and get accountability on this?
- Are you angry with God's message (or messengers) because of any idols in your life that are being threatened?
