

Sermon Notes November 3, 2019 "Experiencing Acts: A Shepherd's Farewell" Acts 20:17-38

Key Text: "Be shepherds of God's flock that is under your care..." (1Pt. 5:2)

Key Thought: Paul both taught and modeled effective Christian leadership

 - a. His humility (v. 19) (cf. Num. 12:3; Mk. 10:45; Php. 2:3-7)
 - b. His message (cf. Acts 26:20; Rom. 1:16; 3:28)
 - c. His disregard for personal risk (v. 24a) (cf. Acts 21:13; Php. 1:21) *"For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain."*
 - d. His lack of greed (v. 33) (cf. Eph. 5:3; 1 Ths. 2:5)
 - e. He covered his needs & those of his companions (v. 34) (cf. Acts 18:3; 2 Ths. 3:7-9)
 - f. His example of hard work (v. 35) (cf. 1 Cor. 4:12; 1 Ths. 2:9)
- 3) Instructions to under-shepherds (cf. Mk. 13:22-23; 1 Tim. 4:16; 1 Pt. 5:2).
 - a. Keep watch! (v. 28a) (cf. Lk. 12:37; 1 Tim. 4:16)
 - b. Be shepherds! (v. 28b) (cf. Jn. 21:15-17; 1 Pt. 5:2)
 - c. Be on your guard! (v. 31) (cf. Mk. 13:22-23; 1 Cor. 16:13)

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION:

- What about Paul's person and character impresses you the most? What qualities do you most want to emulate?
- Are you conscious of your witness (spoken and unspoken) to others? Is your conduct "worthy of the gospel of Christ?"
- Are you humble and open to correction from your pastor and/or ministry leaders? (cf. Pr. 15:31)
