

## Sermon Notes November 10, 2019 "Experiencing Acts: Risking It All" Acts 21:10-14

**Key Text:** *"I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes…"* (Rom. 1:16)

Key Thought: God calls us to fearlessly witness for Him

- 1) Intro & Context
- A willingness <u>TO DIE</u> for Jesus (21:13) (cf. Lk. 14:26-27, 33; Acts 20:24; Php. 1:21; 3:10). *"For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain"* (Php. 1:21)
- 3) <u>TESTIFYING</u> to a hostile crowd (22:1-21) (cf. Mt. 10:16-33; 1 Pt. 3:14-15). "Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness" (Acts 4:29)
- 4) Conclusion
