

"Experiencing Acts: The Journey to Rome" Acts 27:33-28:10

Key Text: "... It is because of the hope of Israel that I am bound with this chain" (Acts 28:20)

Key Thought: Like Paul, our call is to live dangerously for God, requiring great faith and complete dependence upon God
