

Sermon Notes May 3, 2020 "Doing Good" 1 Peter 2:15

Key Text: "Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good" (Rom. 12:21)

Key Thought: We are called to do good, and so shine God's light, even upon darkened hearts, that His light might minister to them.
