

Sermon Notes May 31, 2020 "Wives & Husbands" 1 Peter 3:1-7

Key Text: *"Submit yourselves, then, to God..."* (James 4:7)

Key Thought: Peter calls the wives to humbly come under their husbands' authority, & commands the husbands to humbly respect and care for them
