

Sermon Notes June 21, 2020

"Our Response to Aggression" 1 Peter 3:9-12

Key Text: "Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good" (Rom. 12:21)

Key Thought: God is calling us to respond to aggression with blessing (and sometimes the way to peace is tricky!)

 - b. Seek <u>PEACE</u> (v. 11) (cf. Mt. 5:9; Rom. 12:18; Ja. 3:18)
- 3) Respond with <u>BLESSING</u> (v. 9b) (cf. Lk. 6:28; Rom. 12:14; 1 Cor. 4:12)
- 4) Inherit a <u>BLESSING</u> (v. 9c) (cf. Deut. 28:1-14; Ps. 5:12; Ps. 34)
- 5) Conclusion

- Will you commit, before God, to surrender any hopes or thoughts of revenge against anyone?
- Will you commit, before God, to strive toward peace and blessings for all with whom you have influence?


