

# Sermon Notes August 9, 2020 "Glory Dwarfs Suffering" 1 Peter 4:12-14

**Key Text:** "I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us" (Rom. 8:18)

**Key Thought:** In suffering for Christ, our joy is the promise of the glory that will be ours, eternally, in heaven.
