

Sermon Notes August 23, 2020 "Bearing the Name" 1 Peter 4:15-19

Key Text: "For it has been granted to you on behalf of Christ not only to believe in him, but also to suffer for him" (Php. 1:29)

Key Thought: We are called to boldly bear God's name, despite suffering and persecution, consecrating ourselves for God's work

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION:

- Have you reconciled in your mind, heart and spirit that you will suffer for bearing the name of Christ?
- Has suffering, then, increased your faith, love and perseverance? Or has it weakened your faith?
- Will you consecrate your life fully to God? (or will you hold back, ride the fence, be lukewarm?)

A CLOSE CALL IN CEDAR RAPIDS

August 18, 2020

Ron Newmire's home was bashed in by trees as a violent storm system swept through Iowa and the Midwest early last week. He was grateful to survive and then surprised when a large group of



Samaritan's Purse volunteers showed up at his house to help!

Samaritan's Purse has responded to two locations in Iowa—Cedar Rapids and in Tama

County—to help homeowners like Ron in Jesus' Name as they recover after this devastating storm, known as a derecho.

The August 10 storm brought straight-line winds with gusts as high as 112 mph, tossing cars and toppling trees. Many homes,

churches, and businesses were damaged.
