

Sermon Notes September 13, 2020 "Resistance" 1 Peter 5:8-9

Key Text: "Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes" (Eph. 6:11)

Key Thought: We must understand that we have a mortal, spiritual enemy, and understand how, through faith, to combat his schemes
