

Sermon Notes October 11, 2020 "Combatting Falsehood, Pt. 1" 2 Peter 2:1-10

Key Text: *"So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don't fall!"* (1 Cor. 10:12)

Key Thought: Peter warns us of falsehood among some Christian teachers.

- Is your soul tormented by the unrighteousness in our culture? Or might you be too accommodating?
- Do you trust in God to deliver you from the evil around us? Is your hope in the Lord, or are you succumbing to the pressure?
