# Sermon Notes October 25, 2020 "The Day of the Lord, Part 1" 2 Peter 3:1-10

**Key Text:** "... the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. While people are saying, 'Peace and safety,' destruction will come on them suddenly..." (1 Ths. 5:2-3)

**Key Thought:** The day of the Lord will be a day of horror for the ungodly, while those in God's love will receive mercy and eternal life.

adults. We saw their transformation and were invited into their lives.


