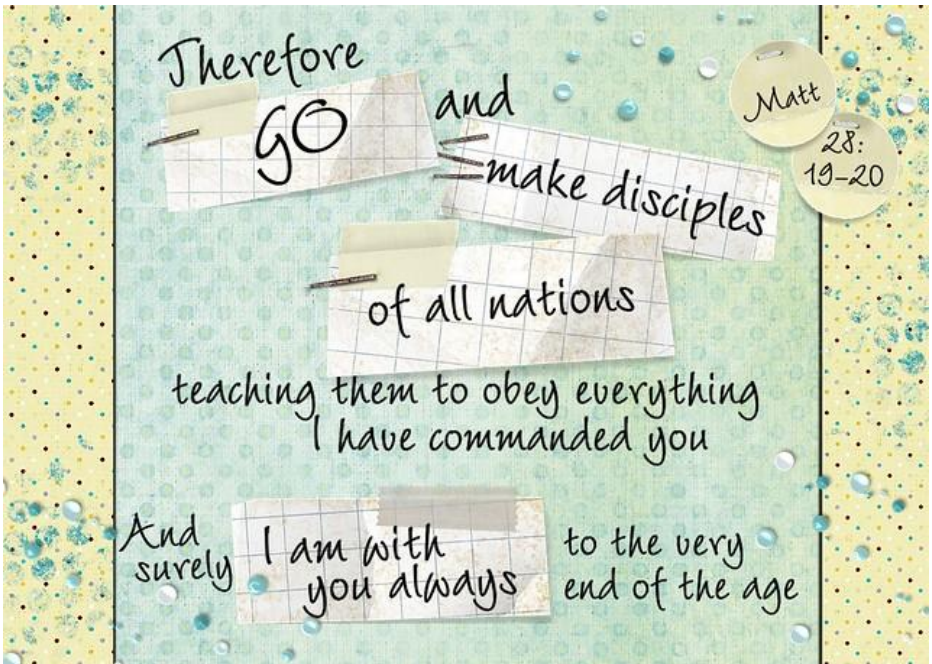

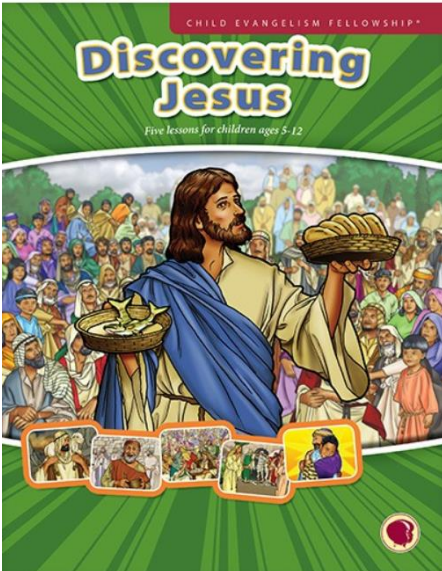

Stand with Christians in India



Persecution against Christians is on the rise across India as a result of new and more restrictive “anti-conversion” laws. While anti-conversion laws have existed for decades in large areas of the country, several Indian states have recently passed new laws that prohibit “coerced or fraudulent conversions.” In addition, they mandate that anyone wanting to change religions must notify authorities or face fines and imprisonment.

This recent legislation has empowered radical Hindus to carry out violent attacks on Christians in their drive to “purify” India by making it entirely Hindu. “The new laws have created a climate where Hindus feel the freedom to question anyone, go into any house or church accusing believers of forced conversions or creating community disharmony because of their Christian activities,” said VOM’s field leader for India. “Hindu groups and individuals feel they have the liberty to ‘police’ their village.” Pray for our brothers and sisters in India.
