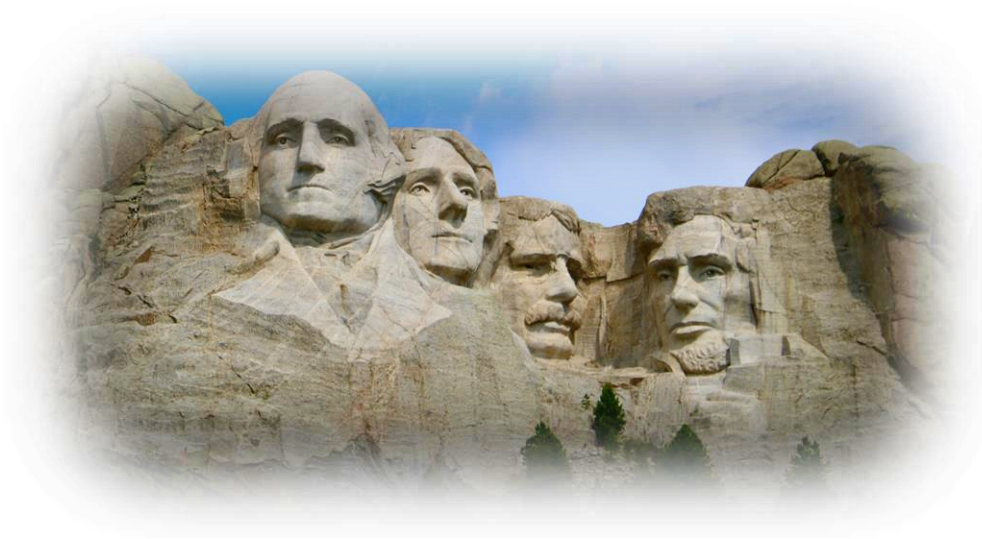

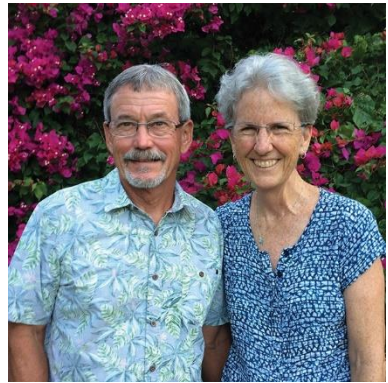

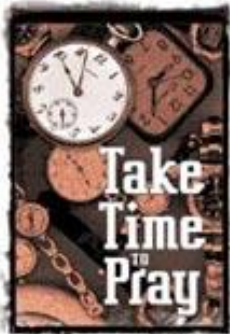
One thing the global church could learn from the CAR church is that church is not just inside the walls, but very definitely outside.
