

Sermon Notes September 12, 2021 "A Prophetic Survey: Amos" Amos 5:6-7, 10-15

Key Text: "Seek the Lord and live" ..." (Amos 5:6)

Key Thought: As our sins are similar to those in Amos' day, so God's message is every bit as relevant: "Repent, seek God, and live."

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION:

- Do you see the striking similarities between our culture and that of Amos? Does our sin and waywardness trouble you?
- Will you heed God's call to repentance (T.H.O.T.)?
- Wherein lies your joy, peace and hope? In the abundance of your possessions? Or in your saving relationship with the Lord?
