

Sermon Notes November 7, 2021

"A Prophetic Survey: Ezekiel"

Ezekiel 1:28-2:3; 3:7-9, 14-15

Key Text: "Do I take any pleasure in the death of the wicked? declares the Sovereign Lord. Rather, am I not pleased when they turn from their ways and live? (Ezek. 18:23)

Key Thought: Ezekiel—the key prophet to the exiles in Babylon—offers us words of warning and of hope for our context and time.

Collection for the Operation Christmas Child Shoebox begins *Monday, November 15.* Labels are here and are available for




your boxes. Fill in the information as before, tear off the stub, stick the label on the box, and it's ready to go.
