

Sermon Notes March 20, 2022 "Trouble" Job 2:10

Key Text: Job 2:1-10

Key Thought:

Should we expect only good things from God?

- 1. Intro & Context Job's story
- 2. Point #1 Why TROUBLE?

Trouble in our life is inevitable [John 16:33, James 1:2, 1 Peter 4:12]:

- From God [Hebrew 12:6, Job 23:10, 1 Peter 1:6-7]
- For God [Matthew 16:24-25, John 9:2-3, Romans 8:17-19]
- Because of God [2 Tim 3:12, John 15:18, 1 Peter 5:8]
- 3. Point #2 TROUBLE IS GOOD

Trouble brings great rewards [John 16:20-21]

- Perseverance & Endurance [Romans 5:3-5, James 1:2-4]
- Blessing [Mat 5:10-11]
- **Restoration** [Matthew 11:28-30]
- Strength [2 Corinthians 12:9-10]
- Eternal Life [Mark 10:29-30, James 1:12]
- 4. Point #3 TROUBLE IS TEMPORARY
- We have peace [John 14:27, Psalm 9:9-10, Romans 5:1-5]
- We have help [1 Peter 5:7]
- We have solution [1 Corinthians 10:13, 1 Peter 5:10]

=> Instead of asking where God is and expecting Him to solve our sufferings/troubles in our ways, we need to trust Him with His way.


Prayer Following Worship: Elim Prayer Team is available to pray with you after the service in the Jeremiah classroom behind the sanctuary.
