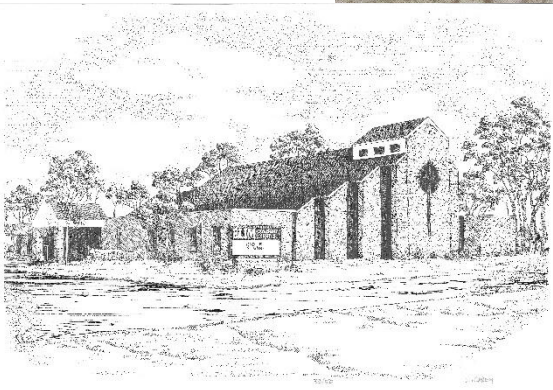

Key Text: *“Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus”* (Rom. 8:1)

Key Thought: God establishes His perfect peace in the hearts of those who are fully surrendered to Him.

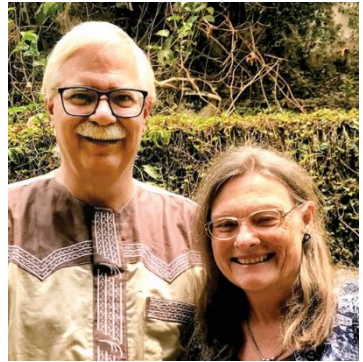

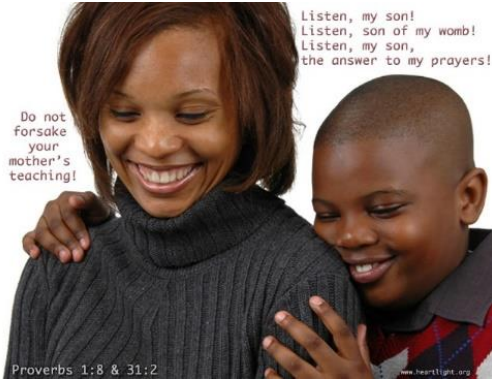
Prayer Cards: Feel free to use the prayer cards for your requests and drop them in the offering plate.
