

Sermon Notes September 11, 2022 "The Law & the Promise" Galatians 3:15-25

Key Text: "And this is what he promised us—eternal life" (1 Jn. 2:25)

Key Thought: The law convicts us of our sin, but leaves us in need of a Savior, that the promise of life might be given to us through faith in Him.

- Do you understand the good purpose of God's Law? Has conviction brought you to repentance? Or are you stuck in condemnation?
- Have you experienced God's promised life? Have you been reborn and renewed through the power of the Holy Spirit?
