Sermon Notes January 1, 2023 "The Purpose of It All" Hebrews 2:10-18

Key Text: "For by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy" (Heb. 10:14)

Key Thought: The purpose of Jesus' advent (the incarnation) was to save us from our sins and make us holy

 - b. To make us <u>HOLY</u> (v. 11a) (thru atonement) (cf. Rom. 3:23-25; Heb. 10:10-14; 13:12)
 - c. To free us from the power of death (v. 14) (cf. 1 Cor. 15:54:57; 2 Tim. 1:10; 1 Jn. 3:8)
 - d. To free us from the slavery of <u>FEAR</u> (v. 15) (cf. Jn. 8:36; Rom. 8:15; 2 Tim. 1:7; 1 Jn. 4:18)

- By faith, have you believed, and so received Jesus' atonement for your sins?
- By Jesus' sacrifice, have you been made holy? By His Spirit, are you growing in holiness?
- Where are you at with your fear factor? Is His perfect love driving out all your fears?
