

Sermon Notes February 19, 2023 "Fishermen & Healings" Luke 5:1-39

Key Text: "Praise the LORD, my soul, and forget not all his benefits— who <u>forgives</u> all your sins and <u>heals</u> all your diseases, who <u>redeems</u> your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion" (Ps. 103:2-5)

Key Thought: We see in Jesus the power to heal, but also His great compassion and love; may we, then, approach Him boldly with faith.
