

Sermon Notes March 5, 2023 "The Good, the Bad & the Ugly" Luke 6:12-26

Key Text: "*The Spirit of the Sovereign LORD is on me, because the LORD has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor"* (Isa. 61:1)

Key Thought: Jesus' perspective on kingdom leadership and qualities is diametrically opposite to this world's perspective.

- The <u>TWELVE</u> (vv. 12-16) (cf. Mt. 10:2-4; Mk. 3:16-19; Acts 1:13 [other lists of apostles]; 1 Cor. 1:18-31 [God chooses the most unlikely])
- The <u>BLESSINGS</u> (vv. 20-23) (cf. Isa. 61:1-3 [good news to poor]; Mt. 5:1-12 [the beatitudes]; 1 Pt. 3:14 [suffering for doing good]; Ja. 2:5 [poor chosen to be rich in faith])
- The <u>WOES</u> (vv. 24-26) (cf. Mt. 19:23-24 [hard for rich to get to heaven]; 23:13-31 [more woes]; 1 Tim. 6:9,17-18 [instructions for wealthy]; Ja. 5:1-6 [condemns heartless rich])
- 5) Conclusion

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION:

- Does it sometime surprise you who Jesus calls to follow Him? Are you surprised He would call you?
- Are you surprised by Jesus' perspective on the rich & the poor? Does it trouble you or comfort you?
- Do Jesus' words convict you? What change(s) do they call you to make?
