## Sermon Notes Sunday, November 19, 2023 "The Contentious King" Luke 19:28-48

**Key Text:** *"Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion! Shout, Daughter Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and victorious, lowly and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey"* (Zech. 9:9)
