

# Sermon Notes Sunday, November 26, 2023 "Tackling Anxiety" Luke 12:22-34

**Key Text:** "Do not be anxious about anything..." (Php. 4:6)

**Key Thought:** God's call—and invitation—is to cast off anxiety and find our peace in Him.
